It time for "Sign-Up" day.

It's that time again and it won't be long before our 2013 season starts. This year the magical day is Tuesday, February 5th at 6.00pm to be held at the Martinez Moose Lodge.

All "Returning Teams" must submit their Rosters on that day. Each team will be receiving the instructions and Roster Forms by mail. If for any reason your team did not receive notification, please send an <u>email</u> to that effect and we will deal with it.

If you are requesting a "Change of Night" you must still submit your Roster on the 5th and pay the fee as if you were playing on the same day as 2012 but must also go to the Club House at the Bocce Courts on the following Saturday, February 9th, to see if there are any vacancies on the night that you required.

This is a "First Come, First Served".

If, for any reason you team cannot play on the same night as 2012, please inform the Club so that your slot can be assigned to another team. As usual, we are expecting a high turn-out for the registration day and vacant slots will be hard to find. Please fill out the Roster Forms with care and also take advantage of the "On-Line" facility, in "Documents Downloads", to type the form and Print it out on your computer, which will reduce errors, especially with the email addresses.

Please put the Capo's name in the first available slot on the form and the Vice Capo's name following. This is so we know who to contact when corresponding with a team.

Last year the Club struggled with finances and this year it has been voted on that the fees have to be raised to \$270 for Open and \$175 for Volo.

Even before the season starts in April, the Club has major expenses to get the Courts in shape and that work will start as soon as this week, should the weather be kind to us. The courts were kept in good condition during 2012 but were breaking up and constant maintenance was required to keep them in order.

Nine of the courts, prior to the season opener, will be rototilled and a new surface will be laid and as I said, this work will be starting very soon.

In addition, the City of Martinez has raised the fees they charge us. In 2013 they require \$1.50 for each member of the Club. In 2014 & 2015 the rates will be \$2.25 and \$3 respectively. It is capped after 2015.

NO "CLUB MEMBER" FEE INCREASE HAS BEEN RAISED FOR AROUND 7 YEARS AND WE CANNOT CONTINUE AS IF IT WERE 2006.

Even with this increase in the fees, it is still the best value sport and if your team has 8 players, it is under \$35 per player, for the whole season.

See you all at the February 5th meeting and we can get this 2013 season underway.
